Update on Fall 2021 Schedule

Dear Students, Faculty, and Staff,

As you may have heard, Baruch College recently shifted course modalities (online, hybrid, in-person) for about 15 percent of our scheduled sections this fall. These changes follow guidance from CUNY and reflect significant improvement in pandemic conditions, allowing for a greater on-campus presence and giving us the ability to leverage the benefits of a reopening NYC.

Mindful of the need for students and faculty to make plans for the coming semester, I would like to assure you that we **do not** anticipate any further large-scale shifts in the course schedule or in the modalities of scheduled sections.
