To help those who are not fully vaccinated, Baruch College has partnered with the City of New York to have **a mobile vaccination van** at the College beginning **tomorrow, Tuesday, August 24**.

About the Van

Any student who has not yet been fully vaccinated can take advantage of the Baruch mobile vaccination van.

- The van is fully equipped with nurses and personnel to safely and conveniently administer the vaccine and monitor patients following their shot.
- Both the one-shot Johnson & Johnson vaccine and the two-shot Pfizer option are available.
- *Appointments are not required.*
